The Special Care Baby Unit at Croydon University Hospital has been caring for very small and unwell babies and their families for over 30 years. The unit has nearly 500 admissions a year, and is staffed by a multi-disciplinary team who are committed to providing the best care they can for our youngest patients.

Surgical wards

- · Vascular surgery, diabetes and wound care unit

Staff receive ongoing training and nurses within the surgical wards have the opportunity to receive training in areas such as:

- Specialities such as breast or bowel surgeries, trauma and orthopaedics.
